### Why study Latin at A-Level?

You will also develop competency in Latin language and a sensitive and analytical approach to language generally. Latin A-Level is highly valued by universities. To take this course, you will need to have studied Latin at GCSE.

#### Comprehension

- 17% of total A-Level
- Based on a prose passage

#### Prose Literature

- 25% of total A-Level
- Literature from writers such as Cicero, Seneca and Tacitus

#### Verse Literature

- 25% of total A-Level
- Verse from poets such as Propertius, Tibullus and Ovid

Learning Latin will help you to understand scientific and medical terminology, as well as enhancing your understanding of the way languages work. It complements English, Maths, Modern Languages and all Humanities subjects. It is highly regarded by universities and employers, as it is intellectually-demanding, with a focus on attention to detail.
