Anto might be a boy, and he might not speak (except using Lego bricks), and he might carry a coat hanger about like it's his closest friend, but that doesn't stop the two of them being like peas in a pod. Conaghan's YA novel sensitively explores what life is like for Anna, a neuro-typical teenager navigating life with her nonverbal autistic twin whilst coping with her parents separation. An honest, funny and enlightening read for students in Years 7 to 10.
